

Setting up Mixer



Welcome to Mixer. Go to the website and signup or sign in. https://mixer.com/



2. Changing Name.

Click on the top right corner robot picture.
Under "Account" you can edit name.
That's it!
Just click on the link our tutors will later send you to watch the live stream, just like youtube.
You could also download the app and watch on your phone.




3. Broadcasting (recommended).

If you wish to broadcast a stream. It takes 24hours to approve so do it soon! Click broadcast.



4. Watch the video.

Click image to start video.





5. Request a stream key.


Click the "Request stream key". Wait 24hours. Come back here the next day. Download OBS on the page.




Broadcast Mixer OBS











1. Welcome to OBS.

This section is completely optional.

Some students may use this broadcasting for their projects as three are interactive features not covered in this guide.

Once your OBS is connected to your Mixer account we can begin!

Basically anything you see within the black area will be broadcasted.

Right side you can chat with anyone in the

2. How to add software into the black area.

At the bottom you will see "Sources".

Click "+" and add a window capture!

A window pops up similar to the screenshot.

Yours should be black. Here you can select a software you have opened on your computer.

In the screen shot I have Sketchup opened up.

You can use any software you like. Click "ok" and you can stretch and resize the window.

3. How to add other stuff in black area.

Theres alot you can add so I will go over a couple more useful ones!
"Video Capture Device" Hooks up your webcam.
"Image" Inserts an image.
You can turn these sources on and off with the eye ball icon next to name during your stream.
Play around with all the Sources!

4. Image Slideshow presentation.

Change slide mode to manual.

Add your images under "Image Files"

Go to File>>Settings top left of the screen.

Go to Hotkeys and find "Image Slideshow"

Change the next slide and previous slides to right and left arrows.

Press "OK"

5. Saving your layout.

Bottom right you can add new scenes to save multiple layouts.

Say you want to do a slideshow presentation then quickly change over to a video and then quickly change over to webcam.

You can create three scenes and just click which ever you want at any point during stream. Alternatively you can also use the eyeball icon to switch back and forth within a scene.
